

Membership & Use of Community Center

Community Center Membership

Membership offers complete access to the center’s amenities, including indoor walking track, gymnasiums, racquetball courts, weight room, and free coffee. District Memberships include Center membership, swim passes, and use of tennis courts. Many fitness classes are free to members. Photo IDs will be issued.

Photo ID’s

ID’s are required for all users of the community center, except those using day passes. Senior ID’s may access some activities listed on “Seniors” page 7.

Day Passes for Visitors

 Resident non-member day pass \$10
 Non-resident non-member day pass \$15

Activation Fee

\$25 is assessed for all new members and includes one photo ID. Fee is due with initial application and for re-activation of cancelled membership (expired over 30 days).

Summary of Code of Conduct

1. Show respect to all with your words and body language.
2. Use all equipment and property appropriately.
3. Wear appropriate attire.
4. Abide by all the rules and regulations of the Center. Written copy is provided at time of membership and posted at Community Center.

Unescorted Minors

Youth 4th grade or 10 years and under, not attending a supervised scheduled activity, must be accompanied by a guardian 16 years or older. After 9PM youth 16 years and younger, not attending a scheduled activity, must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Conduct

1. First reprimand is a warning.
2. Second reprimand, for minors, is a time-out subject to staff discretion based on severity of violation. Minor is required, in the presence of staff, to notify parents/guardians of his/her actions and consequences. Adults will be asked to leave BCCC on second reprimand.
3. Third reprimand for minors is placement in assigned area for remainder of day, awaiting parent/guardian notification and/or pickup. Staff will notify parents. The length of this suspension is at the discretion of the Recreation Department Manager, dependent upon the severity of the violation.
